Admission to the Cathedral for this Service is strictly by ticket only The Company has an allocation of 22 tickets, 13 in the Company pew and a further 9 in the unreserved seating elsewhere in the Cathedral. The Company pew is traditionally reserved for Liverymen but if there are spaces available it may be possible for your spouse/partner to join you there.
