We are sending you this update to announce two very exciting initiatives to increase opportunities for entry into the surveying profession and careers in the built environment.

This latest edition of the Charity Update is focused on our work in the Education arena where the Charity and Education Committees work closely together in delivering our objectives of the Company's 10 year Business Plan. Our overall aim is **to widen the opportunity for entry into the surveying profession and careers in the built environment where entry would previously not have been possible.**

The Company are delighted to announce:

### **UNIVERSITY BURSARY SCHEME EXTENDED**

A partnership has been agreed with Pathways2Property (RREF) to initiate our ambition to provide bursaries for university entry for the new academic year commencing in September 2020. This year we hope to provide four bursaries at £10,000 each per annum to support candidates from hardship, inequality and disadvantaged backgrounds where previously entry would not have been possible – the original core principles of the Chartered Surveyors Training Trust.

This initial programme will accelerate our plans to significantly grow the number of bursaries which we will be able to offer for University and Apprenticeship entry on a nationwide basis. As a key part of the Business Plan, the Company is seeking to widen the opportunities for entry into real estate and the built environment to those for which such opportunities would not have previously existed and this is our next key step in achieving our goal. The aim has been to expand the existing bursary scheme beyond our four existing schools and we are delighted to be able to announce this news. Every member of Livery is able to encourage any potential candidate (Year 12 students) to attend the Pathways2Property summer school.

## SUSTAINABILITY MASTERS DEGREE LAUNCHED



To be known as The Worshipful Company of Chartered Surveyors IDBE Scholarship, the Company, are delighted to announce a partnership with the Cambridge Institute for Sustainability Leadership (part of Cambridge University), to provide a scholarship for a Master of Studies in Interdisciplinary Design for the Built Environment.

The University of Cambridge Institute for Sustainability Leadership (CISL) is a globally influential Institute developing leadership and solutions for a sustainable economy. CISL's Rewiring the Economy framework shows how the economy may be "rewired", through focused collaboration between business, government and finance institutions, to deliver positive outcomes for people and environment in pursuit of the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

As part of the LE Sutton Fund, an annual award will be made to a surveyor or university graduate to undertake a research project on a subject of current interest which will help foster a better understanding of the built environment. This partnership will maximise the benefit of this award and hopes to result in outstanding projects in this key area which affects us all.

Working closely with the University in selection of both the student and project, the Company seek to also build a relationship to help strengthen a positive approach to sustainability.
